## Instructions for Completing School Playground Site Inventory:

- 1. Number of Pieces of Equipment Present: For the third column of this inventory survey, please enter the total number of play apparatus found on site where:
- **E**=Early Childhood Education, **P**=Primary, and **I**=Intermediate intended users.
- 2. Number of Pieces of Equipment (10 years or older): For the fourth column of this inventory survey, please enter the the total number of play apparatus found on site which is older than 10 years. If there is no historical documentation and/or knowledge as to the actual age of the apparatus in question, assume that the item has been on site 10 or more years.
- **3.** Factor Multipliers: For the fifth column of this inventory survey, please multiply the number of pieces of individual equipment by the number specified.
- **4.** Number of Children Accommodated: For the sixth column of this inventory survey, please enter the total number of children that the piece of equipment can accommodate.

Note: Some play activities are rated assuming that a few children may have to wait for their turn. Also, on composite equipment (an apparatus composed of many activities) you need to rate the individual item for accommodating the number of children.)

- 5. When specific equipment is not listed, please find the nearest generic type of equipment possible or list it on a blank space.
- **6.** Game areas are utilized differently by each age group, i.e.;a football field is rarely used by first graders but heavily used by fourth graders. The Factor Multipliers below are general guidelines only. Inspectors should adjust these factors for "observed" usage patterns.
